NEW DISTRICT & AREA BOUNDARIES

1st AREA

- ❖ 2nd thru 7th District Boundaries to remain the same.
- ❖ 1st District – Del Norte and Humboldt Counties
- ❖ New 31st District – Mendocino County

3rd AREA (Boundary Change)

- ❖ 11th, 14th, and 15th District Boundaries to remain the same.
- ❖ 12th District – Stanislaus, Merced, Mariposa, Tuolumne, Mono, and that portion of Madera county lying North of the Fresno River and that portion of Inyo county lying North of a parallel line due West from the Northeast corner of Tulare county to the California / Arizona state line.
- ❖ 27th District - Beginning at the intersection at the Northeast corner of Tulare county line with a parallel line due West to the California / Arizona state line then South to San Bernardino county line then West and South to Highway 2 then West to Interstate 5 then South to 405 then South to Highway 118 then West to Ventura county line then North to Los Angeles county line then Northeast along Tehachapi Mountain range to Tehachapi Pass then North to the Northeast corner of Kern / Tulare county line then North along Tulare county line to the point of beginning.

4th AREA (Boundary Change)

- ❖ 17th District – Beginning at the intersection of Highway 2 and San Bernardino county line then West to Highway 39 then South to 210 then West to Highway 19 then South to Interstate 10 then East to 605 then South to Interstate 5 then South to Los Angeles / Orange County line then East to San Bernardino county line then North to the point of beginning.
- ❖ 19th District – Beginning at the intersection of 605 and Interstate 10 then West to 710 then South to California state line (Pacific Ocean) then East to Los Angeles / Orange county line then North to Interstate 5 then North to 605 then North to point of beginning.

NEW DISTRICT & AREA BOUNDARIES

- ❖ **23rd District** – Beginning at the intersection of 710 and 105 then West to the California State line (Pacific Ocean) then South and West along state line to 710 then North to the point of beginning.
- ❖ **29th District** – Orange County

5TH AREA (Boundary Change)

- ❖ **21st, 22nd, 25th, and 30th District Boundaries** to remain the same.
- ❖ **29th District** will move to the 4th Area.

6th AREA (Boundary Change)

- ❖ **16th District Boundary** to remain the same.
- ❖ **18th District** – Beginning at the intersection of Highway 2 and Highway 39 then South to 210 then West to Highway 19 then South to Interstate 10 then West to Interstate 5 then North to Highway 2 then East to the Point of beginning.
- ❖ **20th District** – Beginning at the intersection of Interstate 5 and 405 then South to Highway 118 then West to Ventura county line then South to California state line (Pacific Ocean) then East to Interstate 10 then East to Interstate 5 then North to the point of beginning.
- ❖ **24th District** – Beginning at the intersection of 710 and Interstate 10 then West to California state line (Pacific Ocean) then South to 105 then West to 710 then North to the point of beginning.
