Realignment

- First-cut presented at DEC Santa Maria last weekend
- Not “good” or “bad”
- Simply a draft at this point

Key Information Still Needed

- Clear problem statement
 - ✓ What is realignment supposed to address (in detail)?
- Description of process used to develop proposed realignment
 - ✓ Meetings
 - When, where, with what groups & with whom?
 - What was consensus of those sessions (minutes)?
 - ✓ What involvement of individual task force members (specifically)?

Full Review & Evaluation Required

- Must occur at District/Post level
- Must use key criteria (measure impact)



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□ Measuring Impact – Suggested Key Criteria

- **How proposed realignment “fixes” issues**
 - ✓ What does it really do to travel time for ALL Posts & individuals?
 - ✓ Will levels of participation/attendance improve – Posts within District?

- **Content & makeup of District Posts**
 - ✓ Relative strength of Posts – did this change & how?
 - ✓ If yes, what are the implications?

- **District resources**
 - ✓ Mix of active & inactive (“on-paper”) Posts
 - ✓ Mix of available District meeting places (i.e., Posts with clubhouses)
 - What will new Posts bring?
 - What will old Posts take with them?

- **District Officers**
 - ✓ What experience lost or gained?
 - ✓ What changes would be required – who leaves?
 - ✓ What Posts involved – new, old, realignment mix



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Measuring Impact (cont'd)

- **District delegate strength – mix by Post membership**
 - ✓ Increase, decrease, remain same?
 - ✓ What does the change mean to the District?

- **District programs (Boys' State, Baseball, Oratorical, et al)**
 - ✓ Increase, decrease, remain same
 - What will new Posts bring?
 - What will old Posts take with them?
 - ✓ Will rebuilding be necessary – teaching new mix of Posts?
 - ✓ What cost to programs involved?
 - ✓ What cost to dedicated Post/District members now involved?
